Six Army men get Shaurya Chakra for anti-terror operations in J&K

NEW DELHI, AUG 14 /--/ India's third-highest gallantry medal in peacetime, Shaurya Chakra, has been awarded to six Army personnel including posthumously to one for displaying bravery in anti-terror operations in Jammu and Kashmir last

year. The recipients of the prestigious award are Major Arun Kumar Pandey, Major Ravi Kumar Chaudhary, Captain Ashutosh Kumar (posthumously), Captain Vikas Khatri, Rifleman Mukesh Kumar and Sepoy Neeraj Ahlawat, according to the Indian Army. It said four Army personnel were conferred the Bar to Sena medal while 116 others were named for the Sena medal on the eve of Independence Day. According to the Army, Major Pandey of the 44th battalion of the Rashtriya Rifles led an anti-terror operation in a village in Jammu and Kashmir on June 9 and 10 last year and showed "unparalleled courage" while neutralising two hardcore terrorists. Major Chaudhary of 55th battalion of the Rashtriya Rifles "exhibited exceptional resoluteness" and fortitude in leading four successful operations by his unit resulting in the elimination of 13 terrorists, the Army said. An operation led by him on June 3 last year was specifically mentioned in his citation. Captain Kumar of 18th battalion of the Madras Regiment has been conferred the Shaurya Chakra award posthumously for displaying "indomitable courage" and professional acumen of "highest order" in saving the life of one of his fellow soldier and eliminating a hardcore terrorist in an operation on November 8 last year. Captain Vikas Khatri from the 16th battalion of the Rashtriya Rifles was deployed as part of a special task of "area domination patrol" in Jammu and Kashmir under the challenging terrain at the height of 12,000 feet on

the nights of December 12 and 13 last year.

The Army said he eliminated one foreign terrorist despite heavy retaliation, showing raw courage and bravery. Rifleman Kumar from the ninth battalion of the Rashtriya Rifles was part of a cordon and search operation launched on the night of July 16 based on specific intelligence inputs of the likely presence of terrorists in a remote village of Jammu and Kashmir. "Kumar physically wrestled with the terrorist, who was shocked by the ferocity of the assault. He kept attacking the terrorist with the butt of his weapon in spite of sustaining a gunshot wound," the Army said. "Unmindful of his injuries, Rifleman Mukesh Kumar neutralised the terrorist from point-blank range ensuring no injuries to own troops or the civilians," it added. Sepoy Ahlawat has been conferred the Shaurya Chakra award for showing "exceptional gallantry beyond the call of duty and nerves of steel" during an anti-terror operation in Jammu and Kashmir on June 20 last year, the Army said.

One hardcore Pakistani terrorist was eliminated in the operation, it said. Detailing about the incident, the Army said a group of terrorists was firing indiscriminately towards the inner cordon of the troops in a bid to escape, taking cover of civilians in the area as human shields. It said Ahlawat waited for an opportune moment and fired accurately on the fleeing terrorists after exercising extreme restraint and displaying composure in the face of a rapidly escalating situation.(PTI)

Three CoBRA commandos get 'Shaurya Chakra' for daring anti-Naxal operation in Chhattisgarh before 2019 polls

NEW DELHI, AUG 14 /--/ Three CoBRA commandos of the Central Reserve Police Force have been awarded the 'Shaurya Chakra' for displaying bravery and killing four "hardcore" Naxals in the worst Maoist violence-affected Sukma district of Chhattisgarh just before the 2019 general elections.

The Shaurya Chakra is the third-highest peacetime military gallantry medal. Deputy Commandant Chitesh Kumar, Sub Inspector Manjinder Singh and Constable Sunil Choudhary belong to the 201st battalion of the Resolute Action (CoBRA) that operates in the dense jungles and difficult terrain of south Bastar area, bordering Odisha, Andhra Pradesh and Telangana, where armed Maoist cadres are the most active in the country. These medals for bravery are among the total 1,380 service medals announced by the Union government for various central and state police forces on the eve of Independence Day.

The ambush by the Naxals and the counter-attack by the security forces

took place on March 26, 2019 near the 'Vate Vagun nallah' under Jagargunda police station area of Sukma, a hot bed of Maoist violence where the security forces like CRPF have seen numerous casualties.

Four Naxals, who had a reward of Rs 8 lakh each, were killed along with the recovery of an INSAS rifle (looted from security forces), some other guns and ammunition, officials said. It was one of the few operations where the security forces recovered the bodies of the Naxalites as they are largely taken away by the ultras. "This operation was a big blow to the core armed formation of Maoists known as the People's Liberation Guerrilla Army battalion." "This major strike against the Maoists, just before the general Parliamentary election of 2019, helped conduct a free, fair, and incident-free elections in south Bastar of Chhattisgarh," the citation for the three read. It added that the troops displayed "unparalleled courage, fortitude and conspicuous gallant action blended with adroit military acumen, without caring for their own

lives in the gravest life-threatening situation."

They saved the lives of their troops and neutralised hardcore PLGA cadres and hence are being recommended for the 'Shaurya Chakra' in recognition of their determination, extraordinary courage and most conspicuous bravery, it said. Apart from these military medals, the country's largest paramilitary force CRPF also won a President's police medal for gallantry (PPMG) and 150 police medal for gallantry (PMG) on the eve of Independence Day. Out of the 151 gallantry medals, 108 are for J&K operations and 39 for action in Left Wing Extremism affected states of Chhattisgarh and Jharkhand. Head Constable Kale Sunil Dattatraya of the 182nd CRPF battalion was given the PPMG posthumously for killing two "hardcore" terrorists in Jammu and Kashmir's Pulwama district in June last year.

Few others in this team, including Constable Gulshan Singh, were given the PMG as per an official list published by the Union Home Ministry. (PTI)

Navy hoists tricolour on Goa island after 'misunderstanding' with locals clears

PANAJI, AUG 14 /--/ A day after the Navy said it has cancelled its event of hoisting the national flag at Sao Jacinto island in South Goa following objections by locals, which prompted Chief Minister Pramod Sawant to issue a warning to the islanders, it finally unfurled the tricolour there in the presence of some residents on the eve of the 75th Independence Day.

The flag hoisting was done as part of the Ministry of Defence's initiative to unfurl the national flag on islands across the nation between August 13 and 15 under the 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav' to commemorate 75 years of Independence. However, there was confusion over when the flag hoisting on Sao Jacinto island would be held. On Friday, the spokesperson of the Navy's INS Hansa base near Dabolim in the state had said that a team from the Goa Naval Area had visited the islands of the state, including Sao Jacinto, as part of the MoD's pan-India initiative.

"However, the plan at Jacinto island had to be

cancelled due to the objection by local residents," he had said. The residents of Sao Jacinto had made it clear that although they were not against the unfurling of the national flag, they were afraid that the Navy's function could be the beginning of the central government taking over the island under the Major Ports Authorities Bill, 2020 in future.

Opposition by the local residents had prompted Chief Minister Pramod Sawant to issue a warning to them that "anti-India activities" would be dealt with an "iron fist".

He had also requested the Navy to go ahead with its scheduled programme. The cancellation of the event due to the local residents' opposition kicked up a row. But the Navy finally hoisted the tricolour in the presence of some locals on Saturday afternoon after a misunderstanding with

them cleared up. "After a slight misunderstanding yesterday (August 13), a team of the Goa Naval Area and residents amicably participated in the National Flag hoisting at St Jacinto Island," a statement issued by the naval spokesperson said. The flag was hoisted around 2.45 pm on Saturday with the residents singing the national anthem along with the naval team during the event, he said. Earlier in the day, CM Sawant had said that the flag would be hoisted at the island "at any cost" and assured full cooperation to the Navy from the Goa police for the event. However, after the event was finally held, Sawant expressed happiness over it. Posting a photo of the ceremony, the CM tweeted, Heartening to see locals at St Jacinto Island joining the Indian Navy in hoisting the national flag. I am glad, better sense prevailed. #JaiHind #NationFirst.(PTI)
